Aim: boosting the interoperability and usability of proof systems





Working group 2 (WG 2) on Automated Theorem Provers

- Aim: promote the output of detailed, checkable proofs from automated theorem provers
- more than 110 participants
- currently chaired by Pascal Fontaine and Alexander Steen









WG 2 meeting: Co-located with PAAR 2022 workshop

Goal:

- bring together members of the different communities working on proofs and automated theorem provers (in the broad sense)
- foster collaborations and build synergies among participants
- pave way for WG 2 deliverables:
 - Inventory of automated theorem provers producing proofs, description of proof formats, and inventory of checking tools for these proof formats.
 - Software for translating proof formats used by automated theorem provers to Dedukti.
